Transport – What is the best way for me to get around Darwin?

- A free accredited shuttle bus service will be offered with dedicated stops to competition venues outside the CBD from 25 April – 5 May.
- Accredited persons will be able to access the Darwin Public Bus network for free by visibly wearing their accreditation from the 21 April.

Visas – I am an international athlete what type of visa will I need?
